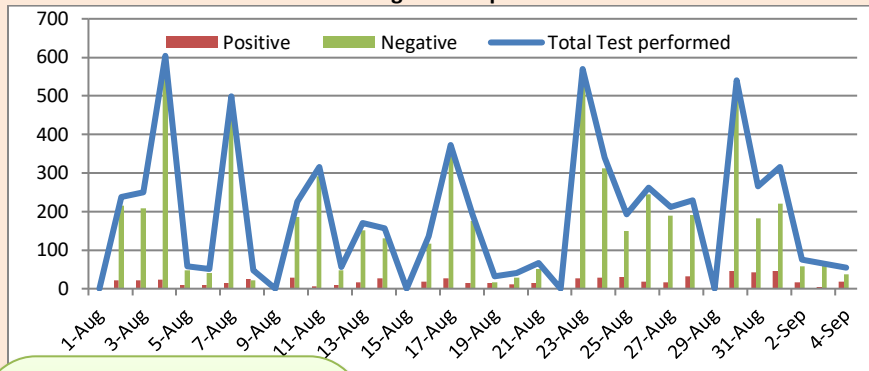
**CORONAL PATIENTS
BED OCCUPANCY – SEPTEMBER 2021**



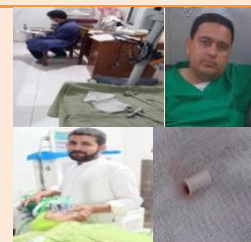
