WHEREAS many of the bidders have responded to this office in relation to their bids; NOW THEREFORE, this draft tentative bids evaluation report containing cumulative technical score is hereby widely shared through the official website of BKMC-MTI in public interest with the following explanations for further necessary action by the concerned bidders:

1. The list attached is a draft tentative Bid Evaluation Report (BER) evaluated by technical evaluation (T&E) committee to serve the only purpose of voluntary disclosure of information to facilitate ensuring all the more transparency and equity in the bidding process by providing equal opportunities to all concerned bidders by enabling them to have access to information related to their bids in the fairness of justice and competition; and
2. This list will be kept on this official website till 12:00 p.m. 10 May 2022; and
3. This draft technical evaluation report (BER) is only an information sharing document as explained above and not an approved legal document to have any authority or weightage or value for any legal proceedings in any court of law or any other forum; and
4. Although every possible effort has been made to prepare this draft tentative BER, the same is being shared to further eliminate the possibility of any error, omission in terms of any details related to the technical evaluation of items quoted by the concerned bidders; and
5. It is stressed to please note that this list is in no way a final approved Technical evaluation report to be used as an evidence or argument for technical qualification of firms against the purchase of drugs for rate contracting from the lowest bidder or award or justification of supply contract / order to the selected bidder by the procuring agency; and
6. All possible efforts have been made to reduce human errors and omissions but still inadvertent errors and omissions may possibly be expected in this BER. All the bidders participating in this bidding competition are expected and requested to thoroughly examine this bid evaluation report and point out any error or omission in terms of total marks obtained in the technical evaluation criteria or any other details which have wrongly been entered into this list.
7. Any feedback related to errors and omissions must reach the office of Manager Material Management, BKMC-MTI Swabi not later than 12:00 p.m. 10 May 2022; in written form duly signed and attested by the responsible relevant person of the bidding entity.
8. This list is only meant to rectify / correct the mistakes, if any that might have occurred during the data entry process for the already submitted technical bids before placing the same before the purchase committee, BKMC-MTI Swabi, for its final approval. Therefore, no new or revised data in technical score, information, claim, explanation, etc. will be entertained for entering into and / or in any way affecting and / or manipulating the list for the benefit to bidding competition by any bidder; and
9. All the bidders are welcome to comment on any deficiencies etc. in this list as related to their technical bids and not on their competitors and / or any other bidders in this list for any other technical bid by some other bidder; and
10. Any comments, feedback etc. received after the above mentioned cutoff time and date (Para-7 above) due to any reason, whatsoever, will not be considered and the so finalized bid evaluation report (BER) will be placed before the purchase Committee, BKMC-MTI Swabi, for its approval in the best public interest; and
11. The Purchase Committee BKMC-MTI Swabi, at its discretion as per prevailing KPPRA Rules may decide to select for local purchase contracting, comparative technical evaluation report (BER) for the current bidding competition 2021-22.
